

Dear Vacation Rental Owner:

The City of Anna Maria adopted Ordinance 15-788 on April 9, 2015, which was amended by Emergency Ordinance 15-794, regulating Vacation Rentals within the city limits of Anna Maria. This letter is to notify you that this ordinance may impact your existing property rights, and you may only have one (1) year from receipt of this notice to pursue any rights established under Florida Statutes, Chapter 70, the "Bert J. Harris, Jr., Private Property Rights Protection Act".

This letter is also to notify you that Article 5 of Chapter 108, "Vacation Rentals" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Anna Maria, provides a method to exempt certain rental agreements entered into prior to April 9, 2015, from the provisions of the Vacation Rental Ordinance. In order to qualify for the exemption, proof of the existence of any rental agreement entered into on or prior to April 9, 2015, must be submitted to the City of Anna Maria for verification no later than July 15, 2015, along with an application form (a copy of which is enclosed hereto).

Full copies of all ordinances enacted by the City of Anna Maria regarding Vacation Rentals are available on the Anna Maria website homepage at: www.cityofannamaria.com. If there are later amendments to ordinances regulating Vacation Rentals, those ordinances will also be posted on that website. EXEMPTION APPLICATION

For rental agreements entered into on or before April 9, 2015 for occupancy on or after January 1, 2016

Note: If VR* owner will comply with VR ordinance, no exemption application is necessary.

* The initials "VR" refer to "Vacation Rental".

This Exemption Application is made pursuant to Anna Maria City Code Section 108-64 for owners of Vacation Rentals who do not intend to comply with the terms of the Anna Maria Vacation Rental ordinance, but desire to fulfill existing rental agreements that were entered into on or prior to April 9, 2015, for occupancy on or after January 1, 2016, and do not intend to otherwise rent their property out as Vacations Rentals after January 1, 2016.

The completed Exemption Application and required attachment(s) most be submitted by U.S. Mail to the City of Anna Maria, Florida, P.O. Box 779, Anna Maria, Florida 34216, or in person or by express carrier (Fed. Ex., UPS, etc.) to City of Anna Maria, City Hall, 10005 Gulf Drive, Anna Maria, Florida 34216, and received by the City on or before 4:00 p.m. on July 15, 2015. For further information about this Exemption Application and the process for its review, please refer to the provisions of Article V of the City of Anna Maria Vacation Rental Ordinance, as set forth in Emergency Ordinance 15-794, a copy of which can be found on the City of Anna Maria website homepage at www.cityofannamaria.com. A separate Exemption Application must be submitted for every separate rental agreement.
